

TAILWAGGERS STANDING RULES

- SR 1. Members are welcome to attend any meeting of the Executive Board.
- SR 2. All bills, itemized and accompanied by receipts, must be submitted to the Treasurer for payment.
- SR 3. All plans regarding meetings, programs, finances and policies must be presented to the Board for approval.
- SR 4. Membership lists may be used only for proper purposes by the Club to promote its objectives and may not be used by members or others for any commercial purposes.
- SR 5. The Club shall remain non-partisan and shall not support nor be controlled by any political party or special interest group.
- SR 6. Following proper notice and hearing, any officers who fail to attend three (3) Board meetings without leave of absence approved by the Board, may be removed from office by majority vote of the Board.
- SR 7. A complete list of members shall be kept by the Secretary and Treasurer and distributed to members in March of each year. This list is for information only and its use is restricted as provided in Rule 4.
- SR 8. The Treasurer may establish and maintain a petty cash fund in an amount not to exceed seventy-five dollars. (\$75.00)
- SR 9. The regular monthly or bimonthly business meeting will be held on the 2nd Monday of each or every second month at 6:30 pm or 7:00 p.m. at the Equestrian Center Lounge. The time and place of these meetings may be changed by notification by the Secretary not less than seven (7) days prior to the meeting.
- SR 10. Yearly operating expenses are to be funded by annual membership dues. Profits from fund raising events are to be used for Club projects and/or other canine associated activities that benefit Bear Valley Springs and local canine rescues and charities.
- SR 11. Annual membership dues are \$30.00 per family payable January 1.
- SR 12. A balance of fifteen hundred dollars (\$500.00) shall be maintained at fiscal year end to fund the succeeding year's Tailwaggers' events.
- SR 13. All proposals from the membership for the donation of Tailwaggers funds in the amount of \$100.00 or greater to other canine associated activities that benefit Bear Valley Springs and local canine rescues and charities shall be discussed, tabled and voted on at the following regular meeting.
